



Class membership requirements



General Class Rule 26. MEMBERSHIP

All crew members on board a competing boat **at Class world and regional* championships** **shall be members** in good standing of the International Hobie Class Association in accordance with the constitution of the International Hobie Class Association.

At all other events **at least one crew member** on board a competing boat **shall be a member** of the International Hobie Class Association in accordance with the constitution of the International Hobie Class Association unless prescribed otherwise in notice of race.

- *Regional championships are defined as IHCA Regional Championships e.g. North American Championships, European Championships etc.*

There are no HOWEVERs here!!



EHCA Bylaw 19:

Membership requirements at national championships.

At the EHCA Annual General Meeting in Toulon, March 6, 2010, it was decided:

National Associations within the EHCA area of jurisdiction **have to** ensure the Notice of Race for their **national Hobie Class championships** is prescribing **all crewmembers** on board a competing boat **to be members in good standing** of the national Hobie Class association in line with the definitions laid down in constitution of the EHCA.

..... and here too, **HOWEVER** is not an option!!
